

Tip for separating EC3 and EC5 lipo wiring connectors

Have you ever had trouble separating the halves of EC3 and EC5 lipo connectors? Or have you worried about pulling the wires off of the connectors when disconnecting a battery? Well, here's an easy way to separate the two halves of EC3 and EC5 connectors without damaging them or the wiring. Simply use a pair of "outside" snap ring pliers (the kind you squeeze and the tips separate outwards). Insert the tips of the "prongs" of the snap ring pliers into the space between the connector halves and squeeze the pliers. The two halves of the connectors will pop right apart. Below are a couple of photos to aid in your understanding. This method may work on other types of connectors, as well, as long as the metal contacts inside the connectors are always shielded by the plastic covers.

SAFETY WARNING: This connector separation method should NOT EVER be used on Dean's connectors (T connectors...the connector type shown on the adapter on the right in the photos) as the tips of the snap ring pliers could come in contact with the metal electrical connectors that are exposed when separating the plug halves, which could result in a short circuit of the battery, and which could cause the battery to explode and/or catch fire.




